Supporting your person to become a certified Nature/Forest Therapist guide can help enhance their knowledge, skills, and guidance to add alternative therapeutic methods, where some of their Deaf, Deafblind, Deafdisabled, Hard of hearing, and/or Late Deafened clients may lack language access. Nature Therapy does not require fluency in spoken language—— as most of the language is communicated between Nature & the client, with the guide/therapist as a facilitator.
